Foam Recycling to Resume at



Deerfield Beach Drop-Off Center

In partnership with DART Container Corporation, the City of Deerfield Beach will begin accepting foam for recycling at the Recycling Drop-Off Center on December 27, 2017.

Residents must follow the following guidelines in order to recycle foam at the Drop-Off Center:

- Make sure your foam has the number 6 recycling symbol.
- Place foam in clear sealed bags.
- Foodservice containers should be wiped clean or rinsed.
- No straws, lids, labels, tape or trash.
- No packaging peanuts or foam insulation.

The Recycling Drop-Off Center is located at the end of 401 SW 4th Street and open on Monday and Saturday, from 8 AM to noon, and Tuesday through Friday from 8 AM to 4 PM.
