Emotional Neglect is a parent's *failure to act*. It's a failure to notice, attend to, or respond enough to a child's feelings. If you grew up in a home where your feelings were not heard, were ignored, were repressed, or overlooked —or if you were made to feel ashamed and guilty for even having feelings, then you may have suffered from emotional neglect.



My goal is to shine a light on neglect by sharing my struggle in the hope that my story will help those of you who are suffering in silence and wondering what is wrong with you identify with my journey and seek help.


Member Dorothy Dunn is supporting the American Legion. One way we can all help is to collect Manufacturers COUPONS (not
