After a brief illness, **DAN BOGNER**, Board Member and Volunteer, went to his Heavenly home on Friday, February 23....very suddenly and very unexpectedly.

Dan could be called the "dad" of the Historical Society's Butler House and Caboose renovation. No matter the job or need, Dan was there to attend to every need....best of all, he was extremely talented and could do ANYTHING!

Dan was also our "go to" man whenever there was a Society activity, from setting up tents and tables, schlepping ice, serving drinks, or taking care of all the everyday needs of the Society.

His compassion and dedication to the restoration of the 1951 Seaboard Air Line Caboose is beyond measure. Dan spent countless ours overseeing the relocation of the Caboose to its new home at DFB City Hall, then spending all his free time rebuilding the interior of the Caboose for future viewing. This was all done as a volunteer, even as his health was deteriorating..

He was the behind-the-scenes worker.....and did EVERYTHING that a homeowner needs to do to maintain the property....he did that with the Historic Butler House and the properties around the House.. Everything he did was with a profound love of and compassion for the Society!

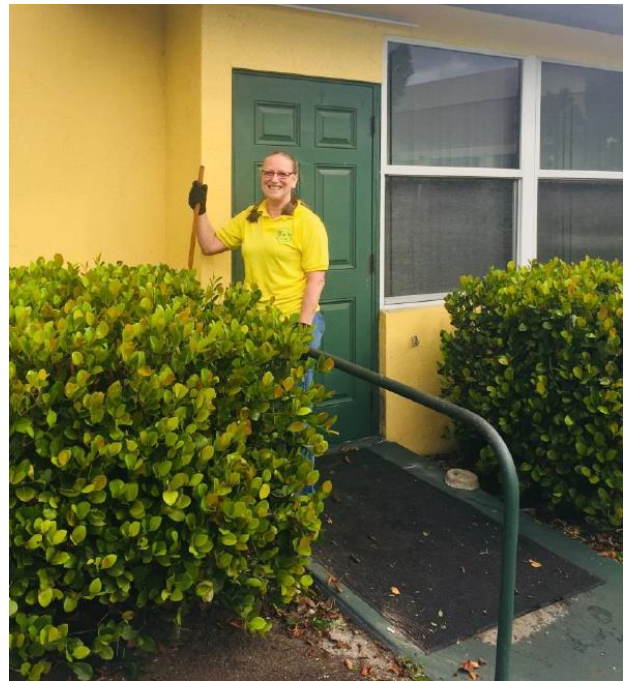
